Level 200+300

You can take a 200- or 300-level class (intermediate) **after any 100-level class**, including *History of Kazakhstan*, passed with C- or above

For example, our intermediate and advanced level classes have included:

- ⇒ **Russia/Soviet Union:** Russian Intellectual History, The Soviet Experiment, Economic History of the USSR and successor States...
- ⇒ **Middle East:** History of Islam, The Crusades...
- ⇒ **South Asia:** India and the British Empire, India since Independence in Bollywood cinema...
- ⇒ **Central Asia:** The Wild East, Land and Population in Russian Turkestan...
- ⇒ **Americas:** US History through Film...
- ⇒ **More than one region:** Atlantic History...

Level 400

You need **6 classes** (18 credits) at level 200, 300, or 400 (intermediate or advanced).

You also need **3 more classes** in History at any level.

In your senior year you need to take:

Directed Readings (Fall) + *Capstone dissertation* (Spring)

Including classes on at least 2 geographic areas; at least 2 classes on history before 1700.

- 3 credits in Philosophy/ Religion
- Critical Issues
- 6 credits in the Humanities

Social Sciences (Sociology, Anthropology, PS/IR, Economics):
15 credits

Sciences & Maths:

- 6 credits in the Natural Sciences
- 6 credits in Maths (or 3 in Maths + 3 in Computation)
